






Hosted VoIP vs. Standard Telephone



	Standard	Hosted VoIP
 <p>COST</p>	<p>Call rates are expensive for long distance and international calls.</p>	<p>Call rates are low or free due to utilizing the internet.</p>
 <p>SOUND QUALITY</p>	<p>Expect traditional, standard-quality calls.</p>	<p>Often as good, if not better, than traditional telephones.</p>
 <p>INTEGRATIONS</p>	<p>Unable to integrate with other systems.</p>	<p>Easily integrates with systems like email, video, and instant messaging.</p>
 <p>MAINTENANCE</p>	<p>Businesses are responsible for their own hardware updates and maintenance.</p>	<p>When a provider hosts and manages VoIP services, often times maintenance and upgrades are included.</p>
 <p>MOBILITY</p>	<p>Little mobility with traditional landlines.</p>	<p>Stay connected whether in an office or on the road. Dial and answer with a business number anywhere.</p>
